

**LIVONIA TOWN COUNCIL  
REGULAR MEETING  
January 12, 2026 – 6:30 p.m.**

The Livonia Town Council met in regular session at 6:30 p.m. on January 12, 2026, in the Livonia Council Chambers, 3111 LA HWY 78, Livonia, Louisiana. Mayor Rhett Pourciau called the meeting to order and directed Town Clerk Donna Bergeron to call the roll, which resulted as follows:

**PRESENT:** Council Members Brian Bergeron, Lester Jarreau, Terry Jarreau, Twanna LeJeune, Lorne Webre

**THE FOLLOWING WERE APPROVED**

**MINUTES:** Motion by Ms. LeJeune, seconded by Mr. L. Jarreau, and carried to approve and publish the minutes as written from the regular meeting on December 8, 2025.

**TREASURER’S REPORT:** Motion by Mr. T. Jarreau, seconded by Ms. LeJeune, and carried, to approve the treasurer’s reports. Budget-to-actual was included for review and comments.

**INVOICES:** Motion by Mr. L. Jarreau, seconded by Mr. T. Jarreau, and carried, to approve the invoices for payment.

**REQUEST FOR REMOVAL OF SPEED BUMPS**

Ms. Katherine Pourciau addressed the Council regarding their previous month's vote not to remove speed bumps on Freneaux and Okelousas Streets, despite a petition showing a majority in favor of removal. The Council agreed to revisit this request at the next regular council meeting.

**RESOLUTION**

A resolution was offered by Ms. LeJeune to formally commit and obligate the town to pay from legally available local funds any portion of the contract amount, change orders, or related project costs that exceed the Capital Outlay funding awarded for the water well project. Budget shall reflect \$278,160 taken from the Sales Tax Fund for this commitment. Mr. Webre seconded the motion and carried unanimously.

**ENGINEER’S REPORT – Gregg Gautreaux and Wade Broussard, PE**

Mr. L. Jarreau made a motion to approve the recommendation of Mr. Gautreaux to pay the request from JNG III Construction in the amount of \$54,009 for the Thorpe Street water line improvements. The motion was seconded by Mr. T. Jarreau and carried.

Mr. Broussard recommended awarding the contract for the drilling of a new water well to the lowest bidder, Griner Drilling, in the amount of \$2,160,000.00, contingent on approval by Facility Planning and Control. Mr. T. Jarreau made the motion as recommended. The motion was seconded by Mr. Bergeron and carried.

**MAYOR’S REPORT – Mayor Rhett Pourciau**

- Construction will soon begin on U.S. Hwy 190 to close the guard rail openings.
- Ms. Kaitlyn Simonsen has been hired as Utility Clerk, replacing Lynn Drago upon her retirement.

***Police Report –Police Chief Landon Landry***

For December: 294 citations were issued, 30 warnings, 6 traffic accidents/incidents, 1 arrest, and 51 complaints were responded to. Total fines collected: \$73,740. Combined totals for 2025 were 5,217 citations issued, 117 warnings, 58 traffic accidents/incidents, 14 arrests, and 571 complaints were responded to. Total fines collected were \$1,077,157.45.

**Public Works and Utilities – Ricky David**

The gas and meter replacement project is in the early stages.

The exterior of the maintenance building has been painted.

Garrett Whittington has been hired full-time and will begin his certification in gas.

**Council Members’ Reports by Department**

- **Junk, Park and Recreation (Brian Bergeron):** Steve Morgan inquired about progress at Glaser Park. Mr. Bergeron stated that Livonia Park & Rec presented a master plan, and work should begin with sidewalk and fence removal.  
Several junk areas are being addressed. The junk violation at Scott Bergeron’s, LA HWY 78, will be addressed in court next month.
- **Drainage & Streets (Terry Jarreau):** A cave-in occurred on Bayou Road due to an undetected water main leak. Livonia Maintenance and Pointe Coupee Parish Government crews quickly repaired the leak and the road.
- **Beautification & Abandoned Buildings (Twanna LeJeune):** Four abandoned buildings/houses are being addressed with the owners.
- **Water & Abandoned Vehicles (Mr. Lorne Webre):** Two nuisance vehicles have been removed.
